

Development of a Flats Recycling Package calculator tool Reference 2020/21 – 01

Clarification questions Part 2 – additional questions

- Is the website hosted on a CMS? If so which one? It looks like WordPress from some research, can you confirm.
Yes, the site is built using the WordPress content managed platform version 5.4.1 and utilises the site theme Salient.
- Would the developers have access to the code base or CMS to develop/test/deploy the calculator?
Yes you would have access to all the site files and database via either the CMS or ftp access.
- You want users to register before using the calculator but there does not seem to be a user login section – would this have to be build or is it “register” (i.e. enter contact details so we can contact you) like your existing toolkits and calculators?
There would need to be a login section to set up registration forms for the calculator.
- Is the data reporting (in Q10. Of the previous questions) going to be online too (e.g. sit inside the admin area of WordPress) or is a daily/weekly/monthly email with csv and pdf attachment enough?

- Which program is going to be used to analyse the user tracking data (Excel, Google Analytics, Tableau, Power BI, other?)
To be decided. However, the site does currently have Google Analytics installed – although it is unlikely that this on its own would cover the requirements.
- You have indicated in your responses that your preference would be to develop an online tool, that users register to use and which will be hosted on your website. In order cost for this, could you please indicate whether you would anticipate that the tool would be hosted on your current environment (ie developed stand alone with links to your website) or whether you are looking for the tool to be embedded into your website? If you, require the tool to be embedded into your website could you please indicate what technology / content management system is being used so that we can cost accordingly.
